WHY ARE WE DOING THIS?

Serra d'Irta is one of the best-preserved natural parks in the Mediterranean area

Existing evidence links motor vehicles with negative impacts on the coastal ecosystem by generating a large amount of dust, soil compaction, loss of vegetation and landscape degradation. In addition, this may generate discomfort for other visitors who prefer to walk or cycle.

There are also detrimental effects on the local fauna, its distribution and behaviour.

Last but not least, the safety of our visitors may be compromised in the case of an evacuation event.

It is in our hands to keep Serra d'Irta well preserved and enjoyable for everyone.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I AM AN OWNER OR RESIDENT?

It is then mandatory to prove the ownership of your property in the natural park area. To do this, you must send us the following documentation at serra_irta@gva.es:

- A document accrediting ownership: a copy of the property summary and title register, or other similar documents.
- The license plate(s) of your vehicle(s).
- Telephone contact.

HOW WILL IT BE DONE?

Access to the coast of the Serra d'Irta Natural Park will be limited to motor vehicles. Two access control barriers have been set up: one in the north by Peñíscola before the Badum Tower and another in the south in Alcossebre, entering via Cala Blanca.

Such barriers, controlled by park personnel, shall only allow access to motor vehicles of:

- visitors who have reserved parking space.
- owners and residents who come to your property.
- authorized vehicles



WHAT SHOULD I DO TO VISIT THE NATURAL PARK BEACHES WITH A MOTOR VEHICLE?

TELEMATICALLY RESERVE FROM THE PARK WEBSITE A PARKING SPACE IN ONE OF THE AREAS ENABLED, TWO-THREE DAYS BEFORE YOUR VISIT. (for example: if I want to book to go on Saturday or Sunday, the reservation will have to be made from 12:00 am on Thursday)

It must be parked exclusively within the **assigned area**.

REMEMBER that to access the coast you must have **reserved space, night parking is not allowed.**

WHEN DOES IT START?

Restricted access by motor vehicle to the park **will start this year from 22 June to 1 September**
